- 5 (f) Any entity that demonstrates to the director of
- 6 finance that the gross income, from all sources, for the entity
- 7 did not exceed \$300,000 in the previous tax year of that entity
- 8 shall be exempt from the requirement to report subawards under
- 9 subsection (d), until the director determines that the
- 10 imposition of such reporting requirements will not cause an
- 11 undue burden on the entity.
- 12 (g) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the department
- 13 of budget and finance from including through the website
- 14 established under this section access to data that is publicly
- 15 available in any other state database.
- 16 (h) The director of finance shall submit to the
- 17 legislature not later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 18 each regular session an annual report regarding the website

12	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
14	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for the
15	purposes	of this Act.
16	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17	budget an	d finance for the purposes of this Act.
