A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEATH CARE INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 441, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§441- Cancellation; default and termination; refund.
5	(a) At any time before pre-need funeral services or pre-need
6	interment services are received by the purchaser or the
7	purchaser's contract beneficiary, the purchaser may cancel the
8	contract containing any pre-need funeral services or pre-need
9	interment services by notifying the cemetery or pre-need funeral
10	authority, in writing, of the purchaser's desire to cancel the
11	contract.
12	(b) Before a cemetery or pre-need funeral authority
13	terminates a contract containing pre-need funeral services or
14	pre-need interment services because of a delinquency in payment,
15	the following conditions shall be met:
16	(1) Four months in advance of the contemplated termination
17	date, the cemetery or pre-need funeral authority shall
18	provide written notice to the purchaser at the

1		purc	haser's last known address and the notice shall
2		incl	ude at a minimum:
3		(A)	The total amount owed under the contract at the
4			time it was originally signed, dates and amounts
5			of payments, adjustments, and credits received to
6			date, and the amount of the delinquency;
7		<u>(B)</u>	An explanation as to how the purchaser may
8			validate continuance of the contract within four
9			months of the date of notice;
10		<u>(C)</u>	A statement that failure to validate continuance
11			of the contract may result in termination of the
12			contract; and
13		<u>(D)</u>	A statement that advises the purchaser of all
14			other requirements under this subsection;
15	(2)	Duri	ng the four month period, but not less than once a
16		mont!	h, and only so long as the purchaser fails to
17		effe	ctuate continuance of the contract as provided
18		here	in, the cemetery or pre-need funeral authority
19		shal	l provide the written notice required under
20		para	graph (1);
21	<u>(3)</u>	If,	however, there is a reasonable good faith bona
22		fide	dispute between the parties as to the amount of

1		delinquency, the four month period shall not start
2		until the dispute is resolved; and
3	(4)	If the purchaser fails to effectuate continuance of
4		the contract by the four month period, the cemetery or
5		pre-need funeral authority may terminate the contract
6		under the terms and conditions of the contract.
7	If the pu	rchaser effectuates continuance of the pre-need funeral
8	services	or pre-need interment services contract within the four
9	month per	iod, the cemetery or pre-need funeral authority may
10	require t	hat the purchaser make payment to effectuate the
11	continuan	ce; provided that the amount required shall not be in
12	excess of	one installment payment of the purchaser's contract.
13	The purch	aser shall resume payment on the pre-need funeral
14	services	or pre-need interment services contract in the amounts
15	and as of	ten as required under the terms and conditions of the
16	contract	and until all payments owed on the contract are paid in
17	<u>full.</u>	
18	(c)	A cemetery or pre-need funeral authority is under no
19	obligatio	n to:
20	(1)	Validate continuance of a contract where a purchaser
21		becomes delinquent again after the four-month period
22		provided in subsection (b) has passed, and may

1		thereafter terminate the contract under the terms and
2		conditions of the contract; provided that the cemetery
3		or pre-need funeral authority gives written notice of
4		the termination to the purchaser at the purchaser's
5		last known address at least ninety days prior to
6		termination; or
7	(2)	Provide pre-need funeral services or pre-need
8		interment services unless the contract is paid in
9		<u>full</u> .
10	(d)	If the contract is canceled or terminated pursuant to
11	subsection	n (a) or (b) or for any other reason, the purchaser
12	shall be	entitled to a refund of the amounts paid by the
13	purchaser	, less amounts that may be retained by the cemetery or
14	pre-need	funeral authority for its costs pursuant to section
15	441-38(b)	. The cemetery or pre-need funeral authority shall
16	make the	refund to the purchaser within thirty days of:
17	(1)	Receipt of the purchaser's written notice of
18		<pre>cancellation; or</pre>
19	(2)	Termination of the contract."
20	SECT	ION 2. Section 441-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
21	amended to	o read as follows:

1	"544	1-3 Map or plat required[+]; unique identifier. (a)
2	The cemet	ery authority [from time to time], as any of the
3	dedicated	cemetery property [described in the certificate of
4	dedicatio	m], or any part or section thereof, is offered for
5	sale, tra	nsfer, or disposition in the form of plots, crypts, or
6	niches, s	hall also:
7	(1)	In the case of land, survey and subdivide [it] the
8		dedicated cemetery property into sections, blocks,
9		plots, avenues, walks, or other subdivisions; make a
10		good and substantial map or plat showing the sections,
11		blocks, plots, avenues, walks, or other subdivisions,
12		with descriptive names, initials, or numbers[+] that
13		uniquely identify each plot;
14	(2)	In the case of a mausoleum or columbarium, make a good
15		and substantial map or plat on which shall be
16		delineated the sections, halls, rooms, corridors,
17		elevation, and other divisions, with descriptive
18		names, initials, or numbers[-] that uniquely identify
19		each niche, mausoleum, or crypt; and
20	(3)	File the maps or plats required by this section in the
21		office of the bureau of conveyances or the office of
22		the assistant registrar of the land court, and

1	maintain a copy of all filed maps as a permanent
2	record of the cemetery authority.
3	[The map or plat shall also be filed in the office of the
4	bureau of conveyances or the office of the assistant registrar
5	of the land court.
6	(b) The cemetery authority shall also maintain a
7	permanent, accurate record of the identity of each person whose
8	remains are located in the cemetery, together with the
9	corresponding unique identifier that indicates the location of
10	the person's remains within the cemetery. The records required
11	by this section shall be prepared and maintained in a manner
12	that will enable the cemetery authority to timely respond to
13	inquiries from the public or the department regarding the
14	location of a person's remains within the cemetery.
15	(c) The cemetery authority shall specify the unique
16	identifier of a plot, crypt, or niche in any document that
17	provides for the sale, transfer, or disposition of the plot,
18	crypt, or niche."
19	SECTION 3. Section 441-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	"§441-12 Mortgages and liens [subject to dedication.];
22	consumer contracts; sales prohibited. (a) Cemetery authorities

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    may secure pecuniary obligations by mortgage or lien upon their
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    property, whether or not the property has been set aside for
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    interment purposes, and may sell plots, crypts, [ex] niches, or
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    contracts containing pre-need interment services subject to such
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    mortgage or lien within the limitations and conditions imposed
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    by this chapter.
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         (b) All mortgages and other liens of any nature hereafter
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    contracted[ - placed, or incurred upon] for and recorded on the
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    property which has been and was, at the time of the perfection
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    of the lien, [with the recorded written consent of the owner of
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    any mortgage or lien, dedicated to cemetery purposes pursuant
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    to this chapter, shall not affect or [defeat] impair the
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    dedication[7] of the property to cemetery use, or the title of
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    any plot, crypt, or niche [owner,] contract, or the obligation
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    of the cemetery authority to fully perform any contract
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    containing pre-need interment services, but the mortgage or
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    other lien shall be subject and subordinate to the dedication
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    and title of any plot, crypt, or niche [owner,] contract and the
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    obligation of the cemetery authority to fully perform any
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    contract containing pre-need interment services, and any and all
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    sales made upon foreclosure, insolvency, or federal bankruptcy
    proceeding, shall be subject and subordinate to the dedication
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- 1 and title of any plot, crypt, or niche [owner.] contract and
- 2 the obligation of the cemetery authority to fully perform any
- 3 contract containing pre-need interment services.
- 4 (c) A statutory lien is created, without recordation of
- 5 the lien, upon all real and personal property held by a pre-need
- 6 funeral authority upon the filing with the department of audited
- 7 financial statements, audited by an independent certified public
- 8 accountant, that indicate that its pre-need funeral trusts are
- 9 not fully funded as required by applicable law. The amount of
- 10 the lien shall be equal to the amount that the pre-need funeral
- 11 trusts are underfunded. This lien shall have priority over all
- 12 subsequent real property mortgages, security interests, and
- 13 liens created upon the real and personal property of the pre-
- 14 need funeral authority and shall terminate at the time when the
- 15 pre-need funeral trusts are properly funded, as evidenced by
- 16 records and certification of the trustee and subsequent
- 17 assurance from the independent certified public accountant that
- 18 the underfunding was corrected.
- (d) Notwithstanding any other language to the contrary,
- 20 sales by a cemetery or pre-need funeral authority of accounts
- 21 receivables from contracts containing pre-need interment, pre-

- 1 need funeral, or perpetual care services are prohibited. Sales
- 2 made in violation of this subsection are void.
- 3 (e) Any transfer of pre-need funeral trust funds and the
- 4 obligations related thereto shall be to another person licensed
- 5 pursuant to section 441-20 or 441-30.5. Any transfer of pre-
- 6 need funeral trust funds and pre-need funeral contracts and
- 7 obligations related thereto in accordance with this section
- 8 shall include the transfer of pre-need funeral contracts made,
- 9 entered into, or purchased by the pre-need funeral authority
- 10 prior to the transfer."
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 441-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "\$441-13 Sale of plots after dedication; sale of
- 14 [incumbered] encumbered plots prohibited unless [incumbrance]
- 15 encumbrance subordinate to dedication. After property is
- 16 dedicated pursuant to this chapter, a cemetery authority may
- 17 sell, transfer, and convey plots, crypts, or niches thereof,
- 18 which plots, crypts, or niches [may] shall be described by
- 19 reference to the map or plat, or amended map or plat, filed in
- 20 accordance with section 441-3 or 441-8. No plot, crypt, or
- 21 niche shall be sold, transferred, conveyed, or otherwise
- 22 disposed of, or offered for sale, transfer, conveyance, or other

- 1 disposition, unless the property on or in which the plot, crypt,
- 2 or niche is included has been dedicated pursuant to this
- 3 chapter, nor shall any plot, crypt, or niche be sold,
- 4 transferred, conveyed, or otherwise disposed of, or offered for
- 5 sale, transfer, conveyance, or other disposition, unless the
- 6 property on or in which the plot, crypt, or niche is included
- 7 shall either be free and clear of all [incumbrances]
- 8 encumbrances or there has been recorded the written consent of
- 9 every [incumbrancer] encumbrancer thereof that the
- 10 [incumbrancer's incumbrance] encumbrancer's encumbrance shall be
- 11 subject and subordinate to the dedication of the property to
- 12 cemetery purposes and the title of any plot, crypt, or niche
- 13 owner."
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 441-22.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 16 "(b) Every cemetery or pre-need funeral authority shall be
- 17 required to provide to the purchaser of cemetery property, pre-
- 18 need interment, or pre-need funeral services and related
- 19 commodities a written contract which shall contain the following
- 20 [disclosure requirements:] disclosures:
- 21 (1) The names and addresses of the cemetery or pre-need
- funeral authority [and], purchaser[+], and contract

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2		the purchaser;
3	(2)	A clear and concise <u>itemized</u> statement of the
4		property, including, for cemetery property, the
5		location of the plot, crypt, or niche by its unique
6		identifier, and any services[7] and related
7		commodities to be supplied or not supplied and by
8		whom, particularly if the authority is not to be the
9		provider under the terms of the contract;
10	(3)	The purchase price of each item of property, services,
11		and related commodities to be supplied, the total
12		purchase price, and how the total purchase price is
13		<pre>payable[+], including any credit terms, if applicable;</pre>
14		provided that, pursuant to section 441-22.7,
15		disclosure shall also be made that further additional
16		charges or fees for perpetual care subsequent to the
17		execution of the contract are prohibited for any
18		purpose and on any occasion, except for reasonable

fees related to the administrative costs of

transferring ownership rights, including the cost of

notary fees, records transfer and storage, and any

research, document and file preparation, photocopying,

beneficiary, if the beneficiary is someone other than

1		othe	er costs directly related to the transfer of
2		owne	ership rights;
3	(4)	Rela	ted costs covered under the contract;
4	(5)	The	basis on which funds are to be deposited in
5		trus	t[+], including:
6		<u>(A)</u>	The name and address of the trustee; provided
7			that the disclosure shall not preclude the
8			cemetery or pre-need funeral authority from
9			changing the trustee named;
10		<u>(B)</u>	The percentage of the contract price for
11			trustable items to be placed in trust; provided
12			that the percentage shall be no less than seventy
13			per cent;
14		<u>(C)</u>	The percentage of the contract price for
15			trustable items that the cemetery or pre-need
16			funeral authority will retain and not deposit
17			into the trust; provided that the percentage
18			shall not be no more than thirty per cent; and
19		<u>(D)</u>	Where a portion of the contract price relates to
20			property, services, or related commodities that
21			are not trustable items, a clear description of
22			what those non-trustable items are;

1	(6)	[Refund] The refund, cancellation, and default
2		provisions of the contract[+], including an
3		explanation of the requirements of section 441- , and
4		a statement in twelve point bold type in substantially
5		the following form:
6		"YOU HAVE REFUND, CANCELLATION AND DEFAULT RIGHTS
7		UNDER STATE LAW AND UNDER THE CONTRACT. PLEASE READ
8		THE CONTRACT CAREFULLY FOR AN EXPLANATION OF THESE
9		RIGHTS";
10	(7)	The date and place of execution of the contract;
11	(8)	The <u>cemetery</u> or <u>pre-need funeral</u> authority's or its
12		duly authorized agent's signature on the contract and
13		the identification of this person by name and title;
14		[and]
15	(9)	A statement that the written contract, when signed,
16		shall constitute the entire agreement between the
17		parties relative to its subject matter and that all
18		obligations of both parties shall be fixed and
19		enforceable by the other parties of the contract[+];
20		and

1	(10) A statement that the contract may not waive any rights
2	of the consumer or duties of the cemetery or pre-need
3	funeral authority under the law."
4	SECTION 6. Section 441-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"§441-24 Inspection of cemetery or pre-need funeral
7	authority books[; annual exhibits]. The books, records, and
8	papers of every cemetery authority whether or not a corporation,
9	which operates or claims to operate a perpetual care cemetery,
10	and of every pre-need funeral authority shall be subject to
11	examination by the director [to the same extent and in the same
12	manner as may be from time to time provided for corporations in
13	section 414 472, as provided by law, and every cemetery
14	authority operating a perpetual care cemetery, and every pre-
15	need funeral authority shall submit such information as may be
16	required by the director in order to furnish information as to
17	whether or not the cemetery or pre-need funeral authority has
18	complied with this chapter.
19	The records of every cemetery authority shall include the
20	information required under section 441-3(b). The records of
21	every cemetery and pre-need funeral authority shall include a

- 1 record of any and all notifications from purchasers or
- 2 representatives of purchasers regarding:
- 3 (1) Any change in address; and
- 4 (2) Notice of cancellation;
- 5 and shall include copies of any and all written notices of
- 6 termination that were sent to purchasers. Change of address
- 7 notices, cancellation notices, and notices of termination
- 8 relating to each contract containing any pre-need funeral
- 9 services or pre-need interment services shall be maintained by
- 10 the authority at all times prior to delivering goods or
- 11 rendering services on the contract and for a period of at least
- 12 six months after all goods have been delivered or all services
- 13 have been rendered."
- 14 SECTION 7. Section 441-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 "\$441-45 Penalty. In addition to the penalties otherwise
- 17 provided by law, any [licensee] cemetery or pre-need funeral
- 18 authority who violates, or [omits] fails to comply with any of
- 19 the provisions of this chapter or rules adopted pursuant thereto
- 20 shall be fined not more than [\$1,000] \$5,000 for each
- 21 violation."

- 1 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007;
- 4 provided that sections 1 and 5 shall take effect on July 1,
- **5** 2008.
