A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTING AGENCIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 489P-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 3 "(a) A consumer who has been the victim of identity theft may place a security freeze on the consumer's credit report by 4 making a request in writing by certified mail to a consumer 5 credit reporting agency, at an address designated by the agency 6 7 to receive such requests, with a valid copy of a police report, investigative report, or complaint the consumer has filed with a 8 law enforcement agency about unlawful use of the consumer's 9 10 personal information by another person. A consumer credit 11 reporting agency shall not charge a fee for placing or removing a security freeze on a credit report [-] of a victim of identity 12 13 theft. A consumer may place a security freeze on the consumer's 14 credit report by making a request in writing by certified mail 15 to a consumer credit reporting agency at an address designated 16 by the agency to receive such requests. If the consumer does 17

not include with the request a valid copy of a police report,

18

- 1 investigative report, or complaint the consumer has filed with a
- 2 law enforcement agency about unlawful use of the consumer's
- 3 personal information by another person, each consumer credit
- 4 reporting agency that receives a security freeze request may
- 5 charge up to \$10 for placing a security freeze on the consumer's
- 6 credit report.
- 7 A security freeze shall prohibit the consumer credit
- 8 reporting agency from releasing the consumer's credit report or
- 9 any information from it without the express authorization of the
- 10 consumer. This subsection shall not prevent a consumer
- 11 reporting agency from advising a third party that a security
- 12 freeze is in effect with respect to the consumer's credit
- 13 report."
- 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
