7	highest value fixed by any appraisal accepted or performed under

9	any acquisition that is made by condemnation.
10	(c) After the land having value as a resource to the State
11	has been acquired or the State abandons the acquisition, the
12	appraisal reports shall be made available for inspection and
13	copying by the public.

15	appraisal shall be required under this section in the event that
16	any interest in land having value as a resource to the State is
17	donated to the State."

Resource Value Lands; Appraisals

Description:

Permits the board of land and natural resources to appraise land having value as a resource to the State before acquiring the land. Permits the acceptance of an interest in land without appraisal if land is donated to the State. Requires the board to submit the appraisal to the attorney general for review and approval. (SD2)
