A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WITNESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 621-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Every witness legally required to attend a state
4	court or grand jury in any criminal case, other than a public
5	officer or employee, shall be entitled to [\$20] \$55 for each
6	day's attendance and a reasonable mileage fee to be established
7	pursuant to rules adopted by the judiciary for each mile
8	actually and necessarily traveled on the ground each way,
9	including travel to and from the nearest airport when required
10	to travel from another island or from outside the [State.]
11	state. In addition to witness' fees, every witness[7] who
12	attends a state court from outside the [State] state shall be
13	entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus
14	[\$110 per twenty-four-hour day,] \$160 for each day's attendance.
15	[or if] If from any island other than that on which the court
16	holds session, the witness shall be entitled to the actual
17	round-trip cost of plane travel[-]; plus \$55 [per twenty-four-
18	hour day, for each day's attendance, except that when the



- 1 witness is required to stay overnight, the witness shall be
- 2 entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus
- 3 \$160 for each day's attendance, which amounts shall cover all
- 4 personal expenses, such as board and lodging. [These per diem
- 5 payments shall be computed on the basis of quarter day periods
- 6 of time.]"
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
