## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WITNESSES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 621-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 Every witness legally required to attend a state 3 "(a) court or grand jury in any criminal case, other than a public 4 5 officer or employee, shall be entitled to [\$20] \$55 for each day's attendance and a reasonable mileage fee to be established 6 pursuant to rules adopted by the judiciary for each mile 7 8 actually and necessarily traveled on the ground each way, including travel to and from the nearest airport when required 9 to travel from another island or from outside the [State-] 10 state. In addition to witness' fees, every witness  $[\tau]$  who 11 attends a state court from outside the [State] state shall be 12 13 entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus [\$110 per twenty-four-hour day,] \$160 for each day's attendance. 14 [or if] If from any island other than that on which the court 15 holds session, the witness shall be entitled to the actual 16 round-trip cost of plane travel[7]; plus \$55 [per twenty-four-17 18
  - hour day, for each day's attendance, except that when the

- 1 witness is required to stay overnight, the witness shall be
- 2 entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus
- 3 \$160 for each day's attendance, which amounts shall cover all
- 4 personal expenses, such as board and lodging. [These per diem
- 5 payments shall be computed on the basis of quarter day periods
- 6 of time.] "
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2008.
