A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	"§11- Candidates for public office; public service
5	announcements; public funds. (a) No person who is a candidate
6	for public office shall appear in, or lend the person's name,
7	image, or voice to, any public service announcement or any
8	advertisement that is produced on behalf of any state-
9	administered program or paid for with state, county or federal
10	revenues, from the time the candidate files nomination papers
11	until the day after the day of:
12	(1) The primary election, in the case of a candidate in a
13	primary election who fails to be nominated to stand
14	in a general election; or
15	(2) The general election, in the case of a candidate who
16	is nominated in a primary election and seeks election
17	in a general election.

- 1 (b) A candidate who holds public office shall be exempt
- 2 from the prohibition specified in subsection (a) if the
- 3 announcement or advertisement is in anticipation of or in
- 4 response to a disaster or state or national emergency; provided
- 5 that the announcement or advertisement is reasonably necessary
- 6 for an official function of the candidate.
- 7 (c) This section shall not be construed to prohibit a
- 8 candidate from appearing in a broadcast of official state,
- 9 county, or federal proceedings."
- 10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
