A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR SPORTS FACILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the erstwhile motor 2 sports facility in leeward Oahu allowed motor vehicles to 3 compete in motor sports under safe conditions and provided a 4 vital service to the community by keeping motor racing and all 5 of its inherent dangers off the public streets and freeways. 6 motor sports facility can also be a benefit to public safety by providing a place to safely train law enforcement personnel from 7 8 the State and the counties, as well as the general public, in 9 the safe handling of motor vehicles. 10 The purpose of this Act is to determine the cost of 11 developing and operating a new motor sports facility on Oahu.
- SECTION 2. (a) The department of accounting and general
- 13 services shall conduct a study to determine the cost of
- 14 developing an all-purpose motor sports facility on Oahu,
- 15 including acquisition of land, construction, and costs of start-
- 16 up, maintenance, and operation.
- 17 (b) The department shall consider at least the following
- 18 cost factors:

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- 1 (c) The department shall submit a written final report to
- 2 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 3 of the regular session of 2008.
- 4 SECTION 3. In addition to the study in section 2, the
- 5 department of accounting and general services may consider and
- 6 execute the temporary acquisition of adequate land for a short-
- 7 term motor sports facility, which may be used until a permanent
- 8 facility is completed.
- 9 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for
- 12 the temporary acquisition of adequate land for a short-term
- 13 motor sports facility.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2025.

Description:

Requires the department of accounting and general services to conduct a study to determine the cost of developing an all-purpose motor sports facility on Oahu, including acquisition of land, construction, and costs of start-up, maintenance, and operation; authorizes the department to consider the temporary acquisition of adequate land for a short-term motor sports facility, which may be used until a permanent facility is completed; appropriates funds for this purpose.
