A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY ON ENERGY EFFICIENT TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds transportation is
responsible for an inordinate amount of fuel consumption,
including fuel used in motor vehicles, busses, and jet planes.
The legislature further finds that reducing the demand for fuel
in transportation modalities would greatly reduce our dependence
on oil.

7 The Hawaii energy policy forum, a part of the social 8 sciences public policy center at the University of Hawaii at 9 Manoa, proposes to conduct a study on energy efficient 10 transportation strategies in conjunction with the department of 11 business, economic development, and tourism.

12 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for an13 energy efficiency transportation strategies study.

SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii energy policy forum at the University of Hawaii at Manoa shall conduct a study on energy efficient transportation strategies in conjunction with the
