(A) Authorizing meetings to obtain information and conduct hearings;

- (B) Determining members, functions, and duties of such committees; provided that the Speaker, notwithstanding any prior authorization or action, may, at the Speaker's discretion, limit the number of members of the House participating on the committee;
- (C) Issuing subpoenas as provided by law or rules of the House;
- (D) Authorizing in writing the payment of any committee related expenditure prior to the payment being made or incurred; and
- (E) Implementing a requirement that a full report of all activities of the committees, including their respective findings and recommendations, shall be made periodically to the Speaker as the Speaker so desires, and to the Legislature within ten days after the convening of the Regular Session of 2008;
