BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 444-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	"§44	4-3 Contractors license board. (a) There shall be a
4	contracto	ors license board of thirteen members.
5	(b)	Of the board members:
6	(1)	Ten shall be contractors who have been actively
7		engaged in the contracting business for a period of
8		not less than five years preceding the date of their
9		appointment; and
10	(2)	Five shall be general engineering or building
11		contractors, five shall be specialty contractors, and
12		three shall be noncontractors. No member shall
13		receive any compensation for the member's services,
14		but each shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling
15		expenses incurred in the performance of duties.
16	(c)	Each county shall be represented on the board.
17	(d)	No one, except the three noncontractor members, shall
18	be eligib	le for appointment who does not at the time of the

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1	member's appointment hold a valid and unexpired license to	
2	operate as a contractor.	
3	(e) Of the board members:	
4	(1) At least three shall be appointed from a list of	
5	nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of	
6	representatives; and	
7	(2) At least three shall be appointed from a list of	
8	nominees submitted by the president of the senate."	
9	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
