A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's fragile and
- 2 unique environment is being negatively affected by the use of
- 3 fossil fuels such as coal, oil, and propane as energy sources.
- 4 Our islands' isolated location makes it even more imperative
- 5 that we become self-sufficient and use diversified energy
- 6 sources.
- 7 Hawaii's global position makes it ideal for the development
- 8 and application of renewable and sustainable energy sources such
- 9 as solar, wind, municipal solid waste, and ocean thermal. We
- 10 have already experienced success with our solar water heating
- 11 and photovoltaic and wind power generation efforts. The
- 12 legislature further finds that the use of renewable energy to
- 13 generate electricity is well established and increasing
- 14 throughout the world with Fiji using seventy-nine per cent
- 15 renewable energy, Austria using seventy-two per cent renewable
- 16 energy, Samoa using almost forty per cent renewable energy, and
- 17 California using thirty-one per cent renewable energy.

1	The purpose of this Act is to preserve and protect our
2	environment and natural resources by prohibiting the
3	construction of any new power plants that produce energy with
4	fossil fuels.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
7	designated and to read as follows:
8	"§269- Renewable energy; prohibition of fossil fuel
9	power plants. The public utilities commission shall ensure that
10	any new construction by an electric utility company shall only
11	be for the purpose of renewable electrical energy. The
12	construction of any new power plants that generate energy with
13	fossil fuels is prohibited."
