A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUNSHINE LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under 92-2.5(b),
- 2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, which provides that two or more, but
- 3 less than a quorum of board members may be assigned to
- 4 investigate a matter relating to the official business of their
- 5 board, the majority of the board members are dependent upon the
- 6 minority's interpretation of the facts, giving the minority an
- 7 unfair advantage over the majority.
- 8 Therefore, 92-2.5(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, should be
- 9 amended to allow any member to participate in a committee
- 10 regardless of whether the number serving on the committee
- 11 constitutes a minority, majority, or the whole of the total
- 12 board membership.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 92-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 15 "(b) [Two or more] Any number of members of a board[, but
- 16 less than the number of members which would constitute a quorum
- 17 for the board, may be assigned to:
