A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. There is appropriated out of the general	
2	revenues o	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so	
3	much there	eof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and	
4	the same s	sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal	
5	year 2008-	-2009, for 7.0 (FTE) ombudsman positions within the	
6	department of education to assure the delivery of quality		
7	services b	by state child serving agencies; provided that one	
8	ombudsman	shall be hired for each school district. Each	
9	ombudsman	shall:	
10	(1)	Assist families in ensuring that their children are	
11		receiving state services that meet the needs of each	
12		child by helping to monitor the performance and	
13		effectiveness of the services being provided;	
14	(2)	Address questions and concerns of stakeholders and	
15		other interested parties with regard to the delivery	
16		of services by state child serving agencies;	

1	(3)	Investigate complaints from stakeholders or other
2		members of the public against a department or child
3		serving agency, or other organization;
4	(4)	Work to resolve individual issues through problem
5		solving with stakeholders; and
6	(5)	Help to identify issues or policies within the system
7		and develop solutions for implementation within the
8		department of education.
9	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
10	of educat	ion for the purposes of this Act.
11	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
