A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY SELF-SUFFICIENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 237, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§237- Exemption on sale of biofuels. (a) There shall
5	be exempted from and excluded from the measure of the taxes
6	imposed by this chapter all of the gross proceeds arising from
7	the sale of biofuels for consumption or use by the purchaser and
8	not for resale.
9	(b) As used in this section, "biofuels" means:
10	(1) Neat biomass-derived alcohol liquid fuel or a
11	petroleum-derived fuel and alcohol liquid fuel mixture
12	consisting of at least ten volume per cent denatured
13	biomass-derived alcohol; or
14	(2) A vegetable oil based fuel, which meets American
15	Society for Testing and Materials International
16	Standard D6751, "Specification for Biodiesel Fuel
17	Blend Stock (B100) for Distillate Fuels, " as amended,

1	•	or a mixture consisting of fuel meeting American
2		Society for Testing and Materials International
3		Standard D6751 with petroleum-based diesel fuel,
4		designated B5, where 5 represents the volume
5		percentage of biodiesel fuel in the blend; or
6	(3)	Any other fuel produced from non-petroleum sources,
7		including natural vegetable oil, plant or other
8		natural resource byproduct, waste cooking oils, fats,
9		greases, or grease trap waste, that can be used for
10		the generation of power; that is commercially usable
11		as a fuel to power aircraft, seacraft, spacecraft,
12		automobiles, trucks, or other motorized vehicles.
13	<u>(c)</u>	Any savings realized from this exemption shall be
14	passed on	to the end consumer and shall not be used by a
15	producer o	or wholesaler of alcohol fuels to raise wholesale
16	alcohol fu	uel prices to increase the wholesaler's or producer's
17	profit man	rgin on the sale of the alcohol fuel.
18	(d)	The director of taxation shall adopt rules pursuant to
19	chapter 91	necessary to administer this section."
20	SECTI	ON 2. Section 237-24.75, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
21	amended to	read as follows:

1	"[+]	§237-24.75[] Additional exemptions. (a) In addition	
2	to the am	ounts exempt under section 237-24, this chapter shall	
3	not apply	to [amounts]:	
4	(1)	Amounts received as a beverage container deposit	
5		collected under chapter 342G, part VIII[-];	
6	(2)	Amounts received for the installation of solar thermal	
7		energy systems in single-family or multi-family	
8		residential properties or in commercial properties;	
9		and	
10	(3)	Amounts received for the purchase of alternative fuel	
11		motor vehicles or hybrid vehicles that are fuel	
12		efficient.	
13	(b)	For the purposes of this section:	
14	"Sol	ar thermal energy system" means a renewable energy	
15	technology system that captures and converts heat from the sun		
16	into a useable source of energy or fuel.		
17	<u>"Fue</u>	l-efficient" means a motor vehicle that meets or	
18	exceeds thirty-five miles per gallon for highway driving and		
19	that can	also operate using non-petroleum biodiesel."

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007;
- 2 provided that sections 1 and 2 shall apply to gross income and
- 3 gross proceeds received on or after January 1, 2008.
