### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended 2 by Act 225, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is amended by amending
- 3 section 42 to read as follows:

- 12 transferred shall include but not be limited to:
- 13 (1) The expending of capital improvement funds for

22	health] relating to the functions transferred to the department
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- 1 of education shall be transferred with the functions to which
