A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,221,956, or so 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and 4 the sum of \$4,032,414, or so much thereof as may be necessary 5 for fiscal year 2008-2009, to provide funds and resources to the 6 department of education, office of information technology 7 services, for an integrated comprehensive student support 8 system, including the special education database, the continued 9 implementation and enhancements to the centralized student information system, a financial management system, and the 10 enhancement of the associated network support services, 11 12 including the establishment of a service center to provide 13 specialized information technology services as requested by 14 schools on a reimbursable basis with the requirement that these 15 funds be separately identified.

16 SECTION 2. The department of education shall create a fee
17 for the service pilot program with the office of technology

services to provide assistance to the schools, school complexes,
 and complex areas based on a schedule of deliverables on hourly
 rates that shall be funded and staffed with per cent of
 the fiscal year 2007-2008, appropriation authorized under
 section 1 of this Act to implement the program.

6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$262,560, or so much 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to 9 establish regional support centers to provide technology support 10 services to schools on the islands of Hawaii and Maui, including 11 the provision of staff, tools, training, supplies, and equipment 12 necessary for the support centers; provided that the pilot 13 program established in section 2 of this Act shall also evaluate 14 the effectiveness of the delivery of support services and 15 provide data to establish a fee for service structure.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$844,440, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the sum of \$850,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to provide additional funds and resources for the expansion of the State's high capacity network to

accommodate ever increasing needs in the use of technology in
 the classrooms.

3 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000, or so 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and 6 the sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for 7 fiscal year 2008-2009, for a facilities asset management system 8 to enable the department of education to link the facilities' 9 inventory with a condition assessment of those facilities' major 10 components and to track and prioritize major and minor repairs 11 to those facilities.

SECTION 6. The sums appropriated by this Act shall be expended by the department of education for the purposes of this Act.
