A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii continues to 2 have a critical shortage of trained teachers within the public
- 3 school system. Research indicates that teacher quality is one
- 4 of the most influential factors in student achievement.
- 5 Standards-based reform has a greater chance of success when
- 6 teacher quality is addressed simultaneously. In an effort to
- 7 provide quality education for its students, the department of
- 8 education continues to recruit highly qualified teachers from
- 9 within the State of Hawaii and the continental United States.
- 10 As more "baby-boom" teachers in Hawaii and across the nation
- 11 retire, the task of recruiting highly qualified teachers becomes
- 12 more challenging each year.
- 13 One way to address the teacher shortage is with programs
- 14 like the Hawaii teacher cadet program, through which high school
- 15 students interested in educational careers may be specifically
- 16 targeted and their skill sets enhanced towards becoming an
- 17 educator. Such programs provide students with information,

- 1 field experiences, and insights into teaching in Hawaii schools,
- 2 and can guide and support Hawaii's future teachers to ensure
- 3 success in the profession.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 5 Hawaii teacher cadet program to address the teacher shortage in
- 6 Hawaii.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000, or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 10 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 11 2008-2009, to the Hawaii teacher cadet program fund.
- 12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii teacher
- 13 cadet program fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000,
- 14 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-
- 15 2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary
- 16 for fiscal year 2008-2009, for the Hawaii teacher cadet program
- 17 to provide programs for students that promote teaching as a
- 18 career choice.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 20 of education for the purposes of this Act; provided that the
- 21 Hawaii alliance for future teachers shall match the amount of

- 1 the funds appropriated for the purposes of this Act, pursuant to
- 2 section 302A-401.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
