A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that national and Hawaii 2 analyses indicate that low-income students, even the highest 3 academic achieving ones, are significantly less likely to 4 participate in post-secondary education compared with their more 5 affluent peers. A major obstacle to their enrollment in post-6 secondary education is a lack of academic preparation that is 7 motivated, in part, by the misperception that college tuition is 8 exorbitant and that the cost must be paid out-of-pocket.

9 The GEAR UP scholars program in Hawaii and other similar 10 programs demonstrate the success of programs that provide 11 college scholarships as an incentive for students to pledge to 12 prepare themselves early for college.

13 The purpose of this Act is to further encourage Hawaii 14 residents to pursue post-secondary education by appropriating 15 funds for the B Plus scholarship program and changing the 16 program's eligibility criteria.
