SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY
STUDY ON THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A CAPITOL GIFT
SHOP IN THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING.

1 WHEREAS, thousands of people visit the Hawaii State
2 capitol, which continues to be admired for its historic
3 features, architectural detail, and aesthetic appeal; and

5 WHEREAS, visitors to the State Capitol have expressed
6 disappointment that there is no gift shop on the premises to
7 purchase mementos or souvenirs of their visit; and

9 WHEREAS, other state capitols throughout the nation have
10 gift and souvenir shops that are financially successful and
11 provide a variety of products for visitors; and

13 WHEREAS, a State Capitol gift shop is a common and accepted
14 method of raising revenues for the State and can also help to
15 make a visitor's tour of the State Capitol a more enjoyable
16 experience; now, therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth
19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the
20 House of Representatives concurring, that the Office of the
21 Governor is requested to conduct a feasibility study on the
22 establishment and operation of a capitol gift shop in the State
23 Capitol building; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
26 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor.
