SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF ADULT RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES.

WHEREAS, an adult residential care home is defined under 1 section 321-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as any facility that 2 3 provides twenty-four hour living accommodations for a fee to adults unrelated to the family, who require at least minimal 4 assistance with the activities of daily living, personal care 5 services, protection, and health care services, but who do not 6 need the professional health services provided in an 7 intermediate, skilled nursing, or acute care facility; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, in recent years, there has been a proliferation of the establishment of adult residential care homes on Oahu; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, many of the adult residential care homes are located in residential neighborhoods characterized by single 14 15 family residences, and in commercial or mixed use areas; and 16 17 WHEREAS, concentrations of the adult residential care homes in these areas have attendant traffic, parking, delivery, noise, 18 19 trash collection, and emergency services response challenges; 20 and 21 WHEREAS, the Department of Health is authorized to license 22 23 the establishment and operation of adult residential care homes; 24 and 25 WHEREAS, the Department of Health's authority is apparently 26 27 superior to that of the City and County of Honolulu's Department of Planning and Permitting to regulate these facilities, 28 29 including the regulation of the locations of the facilities. 30 their distance from each other, and whether they are compatible with the land use; and 31 32

1 WHEREAS, there is apparently no regulation to provide an 2 opportunity for public notice, review, or comment, especially by adjoining property owners, regarding pending applications to 3 establish, modify, or expand adult residential care homes; and 4 5 WHEREAS, while the City and County of Honolulu has revised 6 each of the development plans and sustainable community plans 7 for Oahu in recent years, the Department of Health has not 8 conducted a similar review or revision of its rules regarding 9 adult residential care homes; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the Department of Health should conduct a study of 12 13 residential care home facilities; now, therefore, 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 15 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the 16 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 17 Health is requested to conduct a study of residential care home 18 19 facilities; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in completing the study, the 21 Department of Health is requested to: 22 23 24 (1)Examine and determine the adequacy of the statutes, administrative rules, and inspection and enforcement 25 26 processes, related to the establishment, modification, 27 and expansion of adult residential care facilities; 28 Determine whether adequate opportunity exists for 29 (2) 30 public notice and participation in the inspection and enforcement processes related to the establishment, 31 modification, and expansion of adult residential care 32 facilities; and 33 34 Consult with the Attorney General and the Director of 35 (3) the Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting; 36 and 37 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is 39 requested to submit a report to the Legislature no later than 40 41 twenty days prior to the convening of the 2008 Regular Session; 42 and 43
