## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

## REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO CANVASS LEGISLATION IN OTHER STATES TARGETED SPECIFICALLY AT REDUCING NEGATIVE MEDICAL OUTCOMES.

WHEREAS, physicians and medical facilities throughout the
 country strive to provide the most effective and safe treatment
 and services possible to patients; and

5 WHEREAS, it is unlikely that an entire health care system 6 or even a single provider can ensure perfection consistently 7 over time in the delivery of effective and safe treatment and 8 services for patients; and

10 WHEREAS, the scope of incidents of failure to ensure the safety of patients that result in negative medical outcomes is 11 extremely broad and can range from the general and systemwide, 12 such as allowing conditions to exist that promote hospital 13 infections, to the unique and specific such as negligently 14 leaving surgical forceps within a patient's body after an 15 operation, incorrectly diagnosing a medical condition, or 16 incorrectly prescribing medications for a patient resulting in 17 18 foreseeable harm; and

WHEREAS, it is likely that various private sector individuals, medical institutions and facilities, health care organizations, and the like have instituted programs or established guidelines that focus on reducing the number and scope of negative medical outcomes within their respective medical practices, health networks, or geographic areas; and

WHEREAS, however, it is uncertain whether states have
enacted specific legislation or state programs for the same
purpose; now, therefore,



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BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 1 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the 2 House of Representatives concurring, that the Legislative 3 4 Reference Bureau is requested to canvass legislation in other states that are targeted specifically at reducing negative 5 6 medical outcomes; and 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference 8 Bureau is specifically requested to enlist the assistance of the 9

10 National Conference of State Legislatures in searching for and 11 identifying any state legislation targeted specifically at 12 reducing negative medical outcomes; and 13

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Health is 15 requested to cooperate with and provide any assistance that the 16 Legislative Reference Bureau may request; and 17

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference
Bureau is requested to submit its findings and recommendations,
including any necessary proposed legislation, to the Legislature
no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular
Session of 2008; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 25 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the 26 Legislative Reference Bureau and the Director of Health.
