SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH TO CONVENE A TEMPORARY TASK FORCE TO EXAMINE ALL RELEVANT ISSUES, OTHER THAN MEDICAL MALPRACTICE LIABILITY AND INSURANCE PREMIUMS, THAT MAY CONTRIBUTE TO THE EXODUS OF PHYSICIANS FROM THE STATE.

WHEREAS, there has been widespread coverage in the local 1 media that many of Hawaii's physicians, particularly 2 3 specialists, have chosen to leave the State for various reasons; 4 and 5 WHEREAS, the Legislature is very much aware of this trend 6 7 and of the assertions that medical malpractice liability and costly medical malpractice insurance premiums are contributing 8 to this trend; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, the issue of medical malpractice insurance premiums remains a topic of serious, extensive, and ongoing 12 discussions within the Legislature; and 13 14 WHEREAS, however, the Legislature also wishes to uncover 15 and address additional potential reasons for the departure of 16 physicians from the State to fashion a more comprehensive 17 approach to the problem; and 18 19 WHEREAS, for example, the State's geographic isolation as 20 the nation's only island state located in the middle of the 21 Pacific Ocean may act as a relative barrier to easy interstate 22 migration of professionals, including physicians; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the issue of an alleged monopolistic underwriting 25 structure for reimbursement for physicians in the State has been 26 27 raised as a problem; and 28



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1 WHEREAS, the high cost of living in the State affects 2 everyone, including physicians earning relatively higher incomes; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the State to attain a 6 thorough understanding of the issues that may contribute to the exodus of physicians from Hawaii to better fashion a 7 comprehensive and effective solution; now, therefore, 8 9 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the 11 House of Representatives concurring, that the Director of Health 12 is requested to convene a temporary task force to examine all 13 14 relevant issues, other than medical malpractice liability and 15 insurance premiums, and that may contribute to the exodus of physicians from the State; and 16 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Health is requested to include on the temporary task force: 19 20 (1) The Insurance Commissioner; 21 22 (2) The Director of Human Services; 23 24 25 (3) Physicians; 26 (4)A representative of the health insurance industry; 27 28 29 (5)A representative of mutual benefit societies; 30 (6) A representative of health maintenance organizations; 31 32 33 (7)A representative of the general public; and 34 (8)Any other members the Director of Health deems 35 advisable: and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Health is 38 requested to convene the task force no later than July 1, 2007 39 and to terminate the task force on June 30, 2008; and 40 41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Health is 42 requested to submit findings and recommendations, including any 43 44 necessary proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than SCR LRB 07-3357.doc

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1 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health who, in turn, is requested to notify physicians and representatives of the health insurance industry, mutual benefit societies, and health maintenance organizations, and to the Director of Human Services, and the Insurance Commissioner.

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
