## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO UNDERTAKE A STUDY TO REPORT ON THE STATUS AND NEEDS OF EXISTING TEACHER HOUSING.

13	WHEREAS, the Department of Education will be given sole oversight of the teacher housing beginning July 1, 2008; and

16	WHEREAS, a preliminary inspection of the teacher housing by		
17	the Department of Education has discovered extensive levels of		
18	disrepair and deterioration; now, therefore,
