## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES SENATE TO PASS H.R. 4, KNOWN AS THE MEDICARE PRESCRIPTION DRUG PRICE NEGOTIATION ACT OF 2007.

WHEREAS, there is currently a measure before the United 1 States Senate, H.R. 4, to amend part D of title XVIII of the 2 Social Security Act to require the Secretary of Health and Human 3 Services to negotiate lower covered part D drug prices on behalf 4 of Medicare beneficiaries; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the measure passed the United States House of 7 Representatives on January 12, 2007; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, this measure will save taxpayers money and result in lower costs for those who need the prescriptions by providing 11 an advocate to negotiate the drug prices on their behalf; and 12 13 WHEREAS, this measure will not interfere with the free 14 market system or adversely affect pharmaceutical companies, many 15 of which have reaped large profits from the addition of millions 16 of people who have recently signed up for part D prescription 17 drug coverage; and 18 19 WHEREAS, data provided by AARP Hawaii indicates that half 20 of all of the people in Hawaii, particularly those age fifty 21 years and older and those with lower incomes, are concerned 22 about being able to afford prescription drugs; and 23 24 WHEREAS, over half of Hawaii residents who take 25 prescription drugs on a regular basis report that their drug 26 costs present a financial burden; and 27 28 WHEREAS, nearly one-third of Hawaii residents who take 29 prescription drugs on a regular basis report taking at least one 30 significant cost-reducing measure to pay for their medications; 31 32 and 33



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WHEREAS, the United States Senate should pass H.R. 4 in an
effort to help make prescription drugs more affordable and
accessible to Medicare beneficiaries in Hawaii and across the
nation; now, therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 7 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the 8 House of Representatives concurring, that the United States 9 Senate is urged to pass H.R. 4, known as the Medicare 10 Prescription Drug Price Negotiation Act of 2007; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Congress is urged to support legislation, in general, that will result in lower covered part D drug prices for Medicare beneficiaries; and 15

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 18 United States, the Majority Leader of the United States Senate, 19 the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and 20 the members of Hawaii's Congressional delegation.
