SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII ARTS CENTER FOR YOUTH, THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, AND THE UNIVERSITY LABORATORY SCHOOL TO WORK TOGETHER TO COLLABORATE TO ESTABLISH A FACILITY FOR THE HAWAII ARTS CENTER FOR YOUTH ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT UNIVERSITY AVENUE AND DOLE STREET.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii Arts Center for Youth, a Hawaii
corporation, is a support organization of Ballet Hawaii, Hawaii
Youth Opera Chorus, Hawaii Youth Symphony, and the Honolulu
Theatre for Youth; and

6 WHEREAS, the four performing arts organizations directly 7 provide arts education programming for more than six thousand of 8 Hawaii's students on all islands each year and indirectly serve 9 more than 121,000 children, youth, families and seniors through 10 performances on different islands each year; and

12 WHEREAS, the direct correlation between arts education and 13 improved academic performance is time-honored and proven; and

15 WHEREAS, after cumulatively serving Hawaii for more than 16 one hundred seventy years, Ballet Hawaii, the Hawaii Youth Opera 17 Chorus, the Hawaii Youth Symphony, and the Honolulu Theatre for 18 Youth currently lease space in urban Honolulu and have been 19 forced to relocate many times; and

21 WHEREAS, the four performing arts organizations would all 22 benefit from the development of a facility to co-locate their 23 combined offices, classroom, rehearsal, and shop space that 24 would allow for more efficient and effective operations through 25 shared business practices and shared location; and 26

27 WHEREAS, having permanent, secure space to consider home 28 would allow each organization to better plan for their future 29 and expand programming to service even greater numbers of 30 Hawaii's youth; and 31

WHEREAS, the College of Education's University Laboratory 1 School lost its performing arts facilities in the 2006 on-campus 2 3 fire; and 4 WHEREAS, the development of a Hawaii Arts Center for Youth 5 on land at University Avenue and Dole Street would be an ideal 6 location for a joint project that would allow for in-school 7 programming for University Laboratory School, College of 8 Education teacher preparation, and out-of-school programming for 9 the Hawaii Arts Center for Youth constituents, thereby 10 optimizing the usage of the Center; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the location would allow for other University of 13 Hawaii departments such as theater, dance, and music to utilize 14 the Center as a natural "laboratory" where university students 15 can gain training in arts education and engage in collaborative 16 projects: an ideal place for research and curriculum development 17 in the performing arts; and 18 19 WHEREAS, establishing the Hawaii Arts Center for Youth 20 would create a national model for arts education, offering a 21 full spectrum of training and opening the door for innovative 22 collaborations among different levels of the education continuum 23 from kindergarten to post-graduate levels; now, therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 26 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, 27 that the Legislature strongly urges the Hawaii Arts Center for 28 Youth, the College of Education of the University of Hawaii, and 29 the University Laboratory School to collaborate on the 30 establishing of a facility for the Hawaii Arts Center for Youth 31 32 on the property located at University Avenue and Dole Street; and 33 34 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Arts Center for Youth is requested to submit to the Legislature a report on the 36 status of the establishment of a Hawaii Arts Center for Youth, 37 together with findings and recommendations no later than twenty 38 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2008; and 39 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 41 Resolution be transmitted to the Superintendent of Education, 42 the Chairperson of the Board of Education, the Director of the 43 Hawaii Arts Center for Youth, the Chairperson of the Board of 44 SR LRB 07-3508.doc
