## SENATE RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO PROVIDE EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education is responsible for 1 2 administering its own capital improvement projects pursuant to Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, known as the "Reinventing 3 Education Act of 2004"; and 4 5 WHEREAS, chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to 6 the Hawaii public procurement code, provides for a competitive 7 sealed bid process under section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised 8 Statutes, and a competitive sealed proposal process under 9 section 302D-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 12 process provides for criteria for the award to be set out in the 13 invitation for bids by the government agency making the 14 procurement; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the section 103D-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 17 process, known as the request for proposals process, provides 18 for the government agency making the procurement to similarly 19 set out the evaluation factors in making the award; and 20 21 WHEREAS, "experiential learning opportunity" means any 22 23 learning opportunity that allows the learner to obtain information and learn practical skills that are necessary to 24 perform in the workplace and provides significant experiences 25 with real outcomes that create measurable learning achievements 26 through participation and reflection; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, work on public school and other capital improvement projects provide an excellent forum for providing 30 experiential learning opportunity for students, including 31 students in the construction academies, by the contractor who is 32 33 awarded the project; and 34

WHEREAS, the Department of Education and the Department of
Accounting and General Services should include an experiential
learning opportunity requirement in sealed bid criteria and in
the evaluation factors for competitive sealed proposals; now,
therefore,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education and the Department of Accounting and General Services each report on its progress in regard to the request made by this Resolution to the Legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of the Regular Session of 2008; and
