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SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO STUDY OBTAINING PUBLIC INPUT DURING PLANNING FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 1 Corporation is responsible for the development of affordable 2 housing pursuant to chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 3 4 WHEREAS, affordable housing development is oftentimes done 5 on a massive scale that could disrupt the community in which the 6 project is being planned; and 7 8 WHEREAS, residents of the community affected are entitled 9 to know in advance if an affordable housing development is being 10 contemplated in their area; and 11 12 WHEREAS, residents of the community also should have the 13 ability to have input in the planning stages of an affordable 14 housing project, including such things as traffic, noise, 15 schools, amenities, and suitability; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the community of the proposed affordable housing 18 development may have suggestions to improve the marketability 19 20 and environs for the project; and 21 WHEREAS, advance public input in general is auspicious in 22 planning housing developments; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, 26 that the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation is 27 28 requested to study the means and the method of obtaining advance public input for planned affordable housing developments, 29 including but not limited to: 30 31 (1) Type of notice and frequency of notice; 32 33 Organizations or entities to be given notice, in 34 (2) addition to the general public; 35
