SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO SUPPORT THE ETHICAL RECRUITMENT OF NURSES.

WHEREAS, ethical recruitment is a hiring process free from 1 2 intimidation, misleading information, or exploitation; and 3 4 WHEREAS, ethical recruitment includes transparency in communications and offers of employment, the availability of 5 information necessary for the informed decision making, full 6 disclosure of licensure requirements, adoption of high ethical 7 standards, and sanctions for unethical practices; and 8 9 WHEREAS, nurses have a right to determine the country in 10 which they seek to work, and that a thorough decision making 11 process by nurses can be made only with complete information 12 concerning the implications of relocation; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, nurses coming to practice in the United States should do so under their own free will, with the expectation of 16 17 receiving equal treatment with all nurses working in the United States; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, a proper consideration of ethical recruitment policies is necessary to address the growing shortage of nurses 21 in the United States, and that the health and future of this 22 United States depends in part upon a adequate and appropriately 23 qualified supply of licensed nurses; and 24 25 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State to 26 monitor nurse recruiting agencies and develop sanctions for 27 those agencies that engage in unethical recruitment practices, 28 and collect and disseminate accurate statistics about the 29 30 numbers and types of domestic and internationally educated nurses coming to the State, and their places of employment 31 within the State; and 32 33

WHEREAS, the State recently entered into an agreement with 1 a province in the Philippines concerning the recruitment and 2 relocation to the State of nurses from the Philippines; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the National Council of State Boards of Nursing has just announced that the National Council Licensure 6 Examination ("NCLEX") will be given in Manila, Philippines; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the National Council Licensure Examination is now 9 given in the following cities throughout the world: 10 11 London, England; (1)12 13 (2)Seoul, South Korea; 14 15 (3) Hong Kong, China; 16 17 (4) Sydney, Australia; 18 19 (5) Toronto, Montreal, and Vancouver, Canada; 20 21 Frankfurt, Germany; (6) 22 23 Mumbai, New Delhi, Hyderabad, Bangalore, and Chennai, (7)24 India: 25 26 Mexico City, Mexico; 27 (8)28 (9) Taipei, Taiwan; and 29 30 Chiyoda-ku and Yokohama, Japan; and 31 (10)32 WHEREAS, quidelines are needed for the implementation of 33 that agreement and future agreements with any sovereign nation; 34 now, therefore, 35 36 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 37 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, 38 that the state administration is respectfully requested to adopt 39 quidelines on the ethical recruitment of nurses in order to 40 implement the agreement between the State and provinces of the 41 Philippines relating to the recruitment and relocation to the 42 State of nurses from the Philippines and future agreements with 43
