Sir:

Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1372
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND
INJURY PREVENTION SYSTEM BRANCH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate \$1,900,000 as an
emergency appropriation to reimburse costs associated with the
delivery of emergency aeromedical services on Oahu by the Hawaii
Army National Guard or other provider.

Pursuant to the requirements set forth in Article VII,
Section 9, of the Hawaii State Constitution, the Governor, in her
Governor's Message No. 236 to the Legislature, requested immediate
consideration and passage of this bill, citing an existing
critical funding emergency to continue aeromedical services on
Oahu.


The Department of Defense and Department of Health testified
