Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 861
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to ensure that the prevailing
wage is paid to workers at private construction projects funded by
special purpose revenue bonds (SPRBs) by:

- (1) Requiring that the Director of Budget and Finance (B&F)
report to the Department of Labor and Industrial
Relations (DLIR) on any issuances of SPRBs for private
projects that fall within the definition of "public
works project" in the prevailing wage law but are not
directly caused by a governmental contracting agency;
and
- (2) Requiring DLIR to serve as the governmental contracting
agency and enforce the prevailing wage law for these
private projects.

The Hawaii State AFL-CIO and International Brotherhood of
Electrical Workers Local Union 1186 testified in support of this
bill. DLIR and B&F opposed this measure. The Office of Housing
and Community Development of the County of Hawaii offered
comments.
