Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 14
entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION TO STUDY THE EDUCATIONAL IMPLICATIONS OF THE
SPECIAL NEEDS OF PRESCHOOL AGE CHILDREN WITH DEVELOPMENTAL

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to ensure
appropriate educational opportunities for Hawaii's children with
developmental disabilities by urging the Department of Education
(DOE) to study the educational implications of the special needs
of preschool age children with developmental disabilities.

The Hawaii Down Syndrome Congress supported this concurrent
resolution. The State Council on Developmental Disabilities
supported the intent of this measure. DOE did not support this
concurrent resolution.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 14 and
recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Education.
