H.C.R. No. 275 entitled:

INTERISLAND AIR CARRIERS BY AN AIR CARRIER COMMISSION  
ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO ACT 332, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII

begs leave to report as follows:


The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request the  
United States Congress to enact enabling legislation that would  
permit state regulation of inter island air carriers by an Air  
Carrier Commission pursuant to Act 332, Session Laws  
of Hawaii 1993.

Aloha Airlines offered comment on HCR 275, agreeing with the  
premise that Hawaii is unique as the only island state with no  
highways or rail between the islands and that Hawaii's airlines  
serve as the principal link between far-flung communities across  
our state. Hawaiian Airlines support this concurrent resolution  
and they are grateful for government efforts to promote stability  
in the local airlines industry.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your  
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 275  
and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Consumer  
Protection & Commerce.
