Sir:

Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 278 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO
PROVIDE FOR THE IMMEDIATE REPAIR OF HUI F ROAD, AND URGING
THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO INVENTORY ITS ROADS IN LIMBO,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to promote safe
transportation in the County of Maui by requesting the County of
Maui to:

- (1) Provide for the immediate repair of Hui F Road; and
- (2) Inventory, in conjunction with the Maui community,
Maui's "roads in limbo" to properly establish
jurisdiction of all roads in the County of Maui.

The jurisdiction over a number of roads throughout Hawaii is
in dispute. These roads are known as "roads in limbo." "Roads in
limbo" are often left in disrepair since no government entity
claims responsibility over them. Thus, people who use these roads
on a daily basis suffer due to these roads not being maintained.

Hui F Road on Maui has been deemed a "road in limbo" that is
in need of repair. Your Committee finds that repairing this road,
as well as determining what other roads in Maui County are also
"roads in limbo" will assist the State and county in solving

jurisdictional issues over these roads and will allow for proper repair and maintenance.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 278 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Water, Land, Ocean Resources & Hawaiian Affairs.
