Your Committee on Economic Development & Business Concerns,  
to which was referred H.C.R. No. 68 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING ADOPTION OF THE UNITED  
NATION'S MILLENNIUM GOALS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to join the  
global partnership for a better world by urging the adoption of  
the United Nation's Millennium Development Goals which include  
promoting poverty reduction, education, maternal health, gender  
equality, and combating child mortality, AIDS, and other diseases.

The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Coalition - Hawaii, and  
several concerned individuals supported this concurrent  
resolution. The Department of Education supported the intent of  
this measure.

Your Committee finds that the Millennium Goals are major  
arenas in which significant progress must be made if all people in  
the world are to enjoy the basic human rights of health, food,  
education, and employment, and have a stake in continuing to  
improve and protect their society.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Economic Development & Business Concerns that is  
attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent  
and purpose of H.C.R. No. 68 and recommends that it be referred to  
the Committee on Finance.
