Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 89 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII
TO EXTEND ITS CURRENT LAND LEASE WITH LEAHI HOSPITAL TO
FACILITATE THE EFFECTIVE PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT, AND
IMPLEMENTATION OF A CAMPUS-WIDE MASTER PLAN FOR LONG-TERM
HEALTH CARE SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to encourage the
University of Hawaii to extend its current land lease with Leahi
Hospital to facilitate creation of opportunities and an
infrastructure that will enable alternative community-based
programs that would:

- (1) Be comprehensive;
- (2) Prevent institutionalization; and
- (3) Contain rising long-term care costs.

Leahi Hospital and Healthcare Association of Hawaii submitted
testimony in support of this measure.

Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No.
89 and recommends its adoption.
