Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 91 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY POLICE
DEPARTMENTS TO VIGOROUSLY ENFORCE LAWS RELATING TO THE
OPERATION OF MOPEDS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request the
county police departments to vigorously enforce the provisions of
section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requiring the equipping
and operation of mufflers on mopeds and the prevention of the
modification of any muffler that will amplify or increase the
noise emitted by the moped motor.

No individuals testified either for or against this
concurrent resolution.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 91 and
recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
