Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.R. No. 105
entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO SUPPORT THE
ETHICAL RECRUITMENT OF NURSES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to request that the
Administration adopt guidelines on the ethical recruitment of
nurses to implement the agreement between the State and provinces
of the Philippines relating to the recruitment and relocation to
the state of nurses from the Philippines and future agreements
with any sovereign nation relating to the recruitment and
relocation to the state of nurses from that sovereign nation.

The Representative from the 38th District supported this
resolution.

Your Committee has amended this resolution by:

- (1) Requesting that the Governor continue to support the
ethical recruitment of nurses. As such, the title of
this measure has been changed to, "REQUESTING THE
GOVERNOR'S CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR THE ETHICAL RECRUITMENT
OF NURSES"; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive changes for clarity,
consistency, and style.
