Madam:

Your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and
Affordable Housing, to which was referred S.B. No. 106 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY ON
TWENTY-FOUR-HOUR COVERAGE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish a joint
legislative study group to investigate issues involved in
implementing twenty-four hour insurance coverage in the State and
to make an appropriation to fund the study group.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the
Office of Information Practices.

Your Committee finds that a study is needed to determine what
actions the State can take to combine prepaid health care,
temporary disability insurance, motor vehicle insurance, and other
related insurance systems in order to prevent duplication of
coverage and avoid delays in the delivery of health care. The
intent of this measure is to create a study group to investigate
these issues.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Clarifying that the study group shall be exempt from the
requirements of part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised
Statutes;



- (2) Removing the specified amount of the appropriation; and
- (3) Changing the effective date to promote further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Affordable Housing that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 106, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 106, S.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.


