Your Committee on Tourism & Culture, to which was referred  
S.B. No. 880, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE MUSEUM OF HAWAIIAN MUSIC  
AND DANCE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to preserve Hawaii's unique  
cultural heritage by establishing the temporary Museum of Hawaiian  
Music and Dance Committee (Committee) to investigate items  
relating to, and develop plans for, the Museum of Hawaiian Music  
and Dance.

The State Foundation on Culture and the Arts, Hawaii  
Government Employees Association, Hawaiian Music Hall of Fame, and  
numerous concerned individuals supported this bill. The  
Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism and the  
Hawaii Tourism Authority supported the intent of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Requiring the Committee to submit a final report prior  
to June 30, 2008, that contains a detailed account of  
how all funds were expended and plans for the future  
direction of the Museum of Hawaiian Music and Dance; and



- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style, clarity, and consistency.
