Your Committee received the personal statement and resume submitted by the nominee, and finds Clifford L. Nakea to have the necessary qualifications to be nominated to the Board of Directors of the Hawai'i Health Systems Corporation.

Your Committee received testimony in support of Clifford L. Nakea from Hawai'i Health Systems Corporation's President and Chief Executive Officer, the Chief Operating Officer and Chief Financial Officer, and the Kaua'i Region's Chief Executive Officer.
