HB 1626	RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. Repeals the 12/31/07, sunset date that applies to section 514B-146, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to liens for common assessments.	CPC
HB 1627	RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. Makes technical and conforming amendments that relate to the recodified condominium law.	CPC
