HB 1646	RELATING TO PESTICIDES. Requires retailers of pesticides to verbally warn customers of their dangers, and provide verbal and written instructions for the safe disposal and storage of pesticides prior to consummation of sale.	EEP/AGR, CPC
HB 1641	RELATING TO PESTICIDES. Prohibits the sale of restricted use pesticides by a pesticide dealer to a structural pesticide applicator unless the applicator is directly employed or supervised by a pest control operator validly licensed under Chapter 460J.	EEP/AGR, CPC
HB 1179	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COUNTY OF HAWAII FOR COQUI FROG ERADICATION AND CONTROL. Appropriates funds to control or eradicate the coqui frog.	AGR/EEP, FIN


