HB 1338 HD1 (HSCR510)	MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER ADVOCACY. Provides emergency appropriations for the DCCA Division of Consumer Advocacy to investigate the power outages that occurred on October 15, 2006, on the islands of Oahu, Maui and Hawaii.	CPC, FIN
HB 1943	MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER PROGRAM. Makes an emergency appropriation for the deposit beverage container program.	FIN
HB 1226	MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR ELECTRICITY PAYMENTS STATEWIDE. Makes and emergency appropriation for fiscal year 2006-2007 to cover statewide budgetary shortfalls in electricity payments for facilities assigned to DAGS.	FIN
HB 1227	MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR RISK MANAGEMENT. Makes emergency appropriations of \$800,000 in general funds to the State Risk Management Revolving Fund for fiscal year 2006-2007. Increases the State Risk Management revolving fund spending ceiling \$3,000,000. And increases by \$2.93 million the special fund department's/agency's ceilings in fiscal year 2006-2007.	FIN
HB 1370 (HSCR318)	MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE ADULT MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION. Authorizes an emergency appropriation for FY 2006-2007 (\$8,377,698) from general funds to the DOH, for ongoing services provided by the adult mental health division.	HLT, FIN

HB 1371 HD1 (HSCR668)	<p>MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.</p> <p>Appropriates \$4,980,523 in general fund revenues as an emergency appropriation to enable the Developmental Disabilities Division (DDD) to meet state-approved target numbers under the current Medicaid home and community based service.</p>	HLT, FIN
HB 1372 (HSCR406)	<p>MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND INJURY PREVENTION SYSTEM BRANCH.</p> <p>Appropriates an additional \$1,900,000 in general funds to reimburse costs incurred by the Hawaii Army National Guard or other provider for furnishing helicopter medical transport services on Oahu that were previously provided by the United States Army.</p>	HLT, FIN
HB 1373 (HSCR655)	<p>MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES.</p> <p>Appropriates \$5,299,809 in general funds for FY 2006-2007, for early intervention services for infants and children from birth to three years of age with developmental delay or at biological or environmental risk for developmental delay.</p>	HLT, FIN
HB 1377 (HSCR319)	<p>MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.</p> <p>Increases the expenditure ceiling of the Health Systems special fund to pay for operational costs, and appropriates additional moneys out of the special fund.</p>	HLT, FIN
HB 1378 (HSCR320)	<p>MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.</p> <p>Appropriates \$950,000 in general funds for FY 2006-2007, to fund a grant to Kahuku Hospital on Oahu.</p>	HLT, FIN


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
