HB 1220 (HSCR490)	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL MARKETING. Establishes a special fund to collect revenues from the Hawaii Seal of Quality program.	AGR/EDB, FIN
HB 404 HD1 (HSCR380)	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Appropriating funds for a grant for the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation to conduct agricultural research and development.	AGR, FIN
HB 1941 (HSCR420)	RELATING TO CONTROLLING INVASIVE SPECIES. Appropriates funds to the department of agriculture for the inspection, quarantine, and eradication of invasive species.	AGR, FIN
HB 1924 (HSCR419)	RELATING TO THE ERADICATION AND CONTROL OF THE COQUI FROG. Appropriates funds to eradicate and control the coqui frog state-wide.	AGR, FIN
HB 1179 (HSCR558)	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COUNTY OF HAWAII FOR COQUI FROG ERADICATION AND CONTROL. Appropriates funds to control or eradicate the coqui frog.	AGR/EEP, FIN


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
