HB 666 HD1 (HSCR333)	RELATING TO KUKUI GARDENS RENTAL HOUSING COMPLEX. Increases the ceiling on state revenue bonds issued by the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation to assist the tenants of the Kukui Gardens rental housing complex to acquire the complex in fee.	HSH, FIN
HB 997 (HSCR260)	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR KUKUI GARDENS. Makes an appropriation for the purchase of a property interest in Kukui Gardens.	HSH, FIN
HB 436 (HSCR255)	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. Requires Med-QUEST and Medicaid coverage for chiropractic care.	HSH/HLT, FIN
HB 1120 HD1 (HSCR714)	RELATING TO DENTAL HEALTH. Appropriates funds to the Department of Health for the establishment or expansion of community-based dental health clinics that are operated by federally-qualified health centers to provide a continuum of dental care to QUEST-eligible adults and children, the developmentally disabled, and the uninsured.	HLT, FIN
HB 1471 (HSCR358)	RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH. Ensures the community health care system remains financially viable in the face of population growth, uninsured, and under-insured.	HLT/HSH, FIN
HB 1477 HD1 (HSCR717)	RELATING TO RURAL PRIMARY HEALTH CARE TRAINING. Appropriates funds to develop a statewide rural primary healthcare training program to provide family physicians to rural areas and improve healthcare access for the people of Hawaii. Appropriates funds to support and expand the Family Medicine Residency Program of UH JABSOM's Department of Family Medicine and Community Health to provide rural primary healthcare services. RELATING TO CAREGIVING.

Increases kupuna care program by appropriating funds to expand the program's in-home and access services and provide expanded assistance and support to family caregivers.


Appropriates funds to finance eminent domain proceedings to acquire the Kukui Gardens rental housing complex.
