SB 620 SD1 (SSCR756)	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR HAWAII PREPARATORY ACADEMY. Appropriates \$50,000,000 in special purpose revenue bonds to assist Hawaii Preparatory Academy to finance the construction of its educational facilities.	FIN
SB 1370 SD1 (SSCR850)	RELATING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS. Allows the department of budget and finance to assess fees for the administration of special purpose revenue bonds issued.	FIN
SB 149 SD1 (SSCR41)	RELATING TO STATE BONDS. Authorizes issuance of general obligation bonds. Makes findings required by article XII, section 13 of the state constitution to declare that issuance of authorized bonds will not cause the debt limit to be exceeded.	FIN
SB 1372 SD1 (SSCR848)	RELATING TO MANAGEMENT OF FINANCING AGREEMENTS. Allows state departments and agencies to enter directly into financing agreements to finance the construction of facilities and the leasing or purchase of equipment.	FIN
SB 1260 SD2 (SSCR988)	RELATING TO A GRANT TO KAHUKU HOSPITAL. Makes an emergency appropriation as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, HRS, to Kahuku Hospital to permit it to maintain operations and cover costs of reorganization if it is transferred to the Hawaii health systems corporation.	FIN


