

| HB 1905 HD2 (HSCR738) | RELATING TO DAM SAFETY. Grants department of land and natural resources the right to enter property, public or private, to inspect dams. Allows board of land and natural resources to direct owner or, in its discretion, to take immediate action to initiate emergency measures to insure public safety. (HB1905 HD2) | WLH, JUD |
| HB 38 HD1 (HSCR555) | RELATING TO LIABILITY OF STATE AND COUNTY GOVERNMENTS. Makes certain temporary liability protections for the state and county governments relating to public use of public beach parks permanent; makes temporary liability protection for acts of lifeguards permanent. (HB38 HD1) | WLH, JUD |
