SB 586 SD1 (SSCR844)	RELATING TO STATE FUNDS. Appropriates funds to staff and operate the office of the legislative analyst.	LMG, FIN
SB 1083 SD1 (SSCR42)	RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE BROADCAST PROGRAM. Makes appropriation to hard wire state capitol conference rooms, the capitol auditorium, and both chambers for video broadcasts.	LMG, FIN
SB 1084 SD1 (SSCR43)	RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE PROCEEDINGS ON THE INTERNET. Appropriates funds for archived and indexed video and audio streams of legislative proceedings on the Internet.	LMG, FIN
SB 1711 (SSCR646)	RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE SERVICE AGENCIES. Increases salaries of deputies and first assistants of legislative service agencies from not more than 87% to 92% of the salary of each agency's director.	LMG, FIN
SB 1916 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1279)	RELATING TO CAREGIVING. Strengthens support of family caregivers by, among other things: extending the joint legislative committee on family caregiving; requiring the executive office on aging to conduct a comprehensive assessment of care recipients' needs and the needs of their family caregivers; and appropriating funds to expand services for care recipients and their family caregivers.
