Requires department of accounting and general services to conduct a study to determine the cost of developing an all-purpose motor sports facility in the State, including acquisition of land, construction, and cost of start-up, maintenance, and operation. HB 659	RELATING TO TARO. Establishes the taro plant as the state plant.	TAC/WLH, JUD
HB 1169	RELATING TO HISTORIC SITES. Requires landowner of a potential native Hawaiian historical site on private property to obtain prior approval of the department of land and natural resources before conducting certain activities on the land; specifies procedures; defines "potential native Hawaiian historic site." HB 249	RELATING TO HUNTING TOURISM. Provides for a fee of \$50 for a 3-day hunting license on a private or commercial shooting preserve with a licensed guide.	WLH/TAC, FIN


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


